Belle Isle Municipal Election in March

On Tuesday, March 14, 2017 a municipal election will be held in Belle Isle to fill the City Council seat for Belle Isle District No. 7. Two candidates qualified to run for the seat: Incumbent Sue Nielsen, a Lake Conway Estates resident residing on St. Germain Avenue, and John Evertsen, also a Lake Conway Estates resident, whose home is on Dorian Avenue.

District 1 Commissioner, Ed Gold, was unopposed in the qualifying process and has therefore been declared elected. Commissioner Gold is also a Lake Conway Estates resident and lives on Cullen Lake Shore Drive.

The polling place for qualified voters in Lake Conway Estates is Precinct 334, Pine Castle Masonic Lodge at 1216 Hoffner Avenue. For additional information contact the Belle Isle City Clerk at 407-851-7730 or the Orange County Supervisor of Elections office at 407-836-2070.

What's in a Name?

Were you aware that how you list your city of residence for some household bills could be shortchanging the City of Belle Isle and its residents the tax revenues to which it is entitled? If you receive a monthly bill for television service, internet connection, or phone service, you pay a Communications Service Tax. Same thing with new phone purchases.



Within the 32812 zip code, U.S. mail will be delivered to appropriate addresses in Belle Isle whether the city is listed as Orlando or Belle Isle. However, the collected Communications Service Taxes are remitted to the city you list in your address. By declaring your address as Orlando, the tax dollars that should be coming back to your home town go instead to that city and Belle Isle does not benefit. Something to think about!
