Annual Meeting Recap

In the aftermath of Hurricane Irma---almost two weeks after that angry storm had its way with central Florida---members of Lake Conway Estates Residents' Association for Fiscal Year 2017/2018, met to hold the Annual Meeting of their corporation. The venue was the fellowship hall of the First Baptist Church of Pine Castle on Hoffner Avenue.

The traditional pot luck supper was held prior to the annual meeting for those members who wished to participate. Residents also had an opportunity to take advantage of the discounted LCERA membership fee by remitting their annual dues prior to the meeting's start. For those who had wished to do so, keys for the lake lot gates and the tennis court gate could be exchanged or secured prior to the meeting.

Those residents who had chosen to remit their dues via U.S. Mail, PayPal, or in person to Membership Chairman, Barbie Snavely, in the days before the September 21 meeting, helped assure that there were no big backups at the registration table before the meeting began. Likewise, early exchange of keys for the lake lot and tennis courts via Barbie in the days prior to the meeting also kept things moving at the registration table the evening of the meeting. Early key exchange was tried out last year with good success and was continued this year.

From the *call to order* through *adjournment* the meeting lasted no more than 30 minutes but covered a lot of ground. Out-going President, Steve Udouj, reviewed administrative highlights of the fiscal year which ended August 31. Steve also reported on the projects that had been undertaken for that same period which included pressure washing and painting the lake lot boat dock, removal of old mulch and replacement with sand at the playground, installation of an electrical box at the lake lot pavilion, replacement of a section of damaged fencing at the tennis courts, and rebuilding the damaged entry gate at the tennis courts and utilizing a new locking system there. LCERA also sponsored two community events in April---the Easter Egg Hunt on the 15th, and the Annual Picnic on the 30th.

Out-going Treasurer, Jennifer Hinkle, discussed the various financial reports she had prepared and there was review of the various reserve funds that have been created to prepare for anticipated replacements and repairs. Utilizing information from the budget of the past year as guideline, a budget for 2017/2018 had been prepared and was approved by the membership.

The slate of officers for the 2017/2018 Executive Council was introduced; there were no nominations from the floor. In-coming Council members are Bob Buzzetti, President; Jenny Palmer, Vice-President; David Sherard, Treasurer; and Rosie Maltby, Secretary.

In Belle Isle

Republic Services is the sole provider of solid waste, yard waste, and recycling pickup

in the city. In Lake Conway Estates, Fridays are collection days for recycling materials. But what, you might ask, constitutes recycling material? On the City's website at www.cityofbelleisle.org you can find a helpful flyer entitled "Let's Talk Trash." The flyer provides the following information about the Belle Isle recycling program:

- Glass containers, newspaper, ferrous metal, aluminum containers/cans, No. 1 through No. 7 plastic containers that contained non-toxic products are considered materials for recycling.
- All materials are collected commingled, so separation is not necessary.
- Bins for recycling materials are available for \$9.25 each and may be obtained at City Hall, 1600 Nela Avenue, Belle Isle, FL (checks and credit card payment are accepted).



Residents on Duban Avenue (17 homes) and Ponceau Avenue (7 homes) are in need of a Street Captain who will assist with delivery of *The Crow's Nest* newsletter and periodic information of benefit to all in Lake Conway Estates.
